The Chief Guest was Mr. Arun Dev Gautam, IG Police (CG). The main speakers were Mr. Atul Kothari, Shiksha Uthan Samiti, Delhi and Dr. Sachidanand Joshi, Vice-Chancellor, Kusha Bhau Thakrey Journalism and Mass Communication University, Raipur. The program started with the lighting of the lamp and garlanding the idol of Maa Saraswati followed by Saraswati Vandana, which was sung by the students of B.Sc. A skit was presented by the B.Ed students on the condition of women in the society. There after saplings were presented to the dignitaries present for the program.

Welcome speech was given by Principal Dr. Raksha Singh, in which she said that every teacher is a sculpture and they can guide/mould the students on the right path of success and progress. A teacher in herself is a complete encyclopedia of knowledge and culture.

Additional Director Dr. JDP Rao said that teachers are the mentors of the society. He further added that only through education one can build a good character and this two days workshop is being conducted to know what are the devices that can be used to build a good character.

Vice-President of Shri Ganagajali Education Society Mr. Abhishek Mishra told that India cannot be made beautiful by artificial things, it can be made beautiful



if every person of society is cultured, educated and through this workshop let's take an initiative for the personality and character development, which is essential for the success of our country.

Dr. Sacchidanand Joshi added to the subject that we should be careful about our character, because a small issue is spotted and is blown like anything by others. Character is like a white cloth on which any mistake is viewed as black spot and highlighted. He said that people of today lives in grey colour, because it's very easy to maintain that colour and hide the mistakes.

At the end of the inaugural function, vote of thanks was given by Dr. Shaïd Ali, HoD, Khushabhau Thakrey Journalism and Mass Communication University, Raipur. The conveyor of the program was Mr. Santosh Sharma, B.Ed Department and program was anchored by Mrs. Sushma Dubey, B.Ed Department.

Speaking on Dressing style, he said that dress should be one in which one feels comfortable but now dresses are becoming small and tight which in turns blocks the air system and blood vessels and also put pressure on various vital parts of the body which are in turn harmful and dangerous for the body.

He said that we are suffering from vitamin D deficiency and taking it orally where as in the nature it is present and we can get enough of it while doing Suryanamaskar, which keeps the body fresh and fit.

Later the students were given to answer which was followed by a questionnaire in which students asked various questions realated to varioushealth issues. Dr. Manohar brilliantly answered all the questions and cleared the doubts of the students.




Two days workshop was for all the academic and non-academic staff



Major Patent Offices are at Delhi, Kolkata, Mumbai, and Chennai.

An awareness of Patents and intellectual property Rights helps to create an educated and receptive decision making, within an organization. The motive behind this workshop is to make the organization are of the opportunities for value creation by generating and exploiting IP assets such as Patents and trade secrets.

Chief Guest of the program were Dr.K. Subramaniam (Director General, CGCOST, Raipur) and Shri. I.P. Mishra, President of Shri Gangajali Education Society. Dr. J.D.P. Rao, Additional Director of the college, Dr. Raksha Singh, College Principal were also shared the dais.

Shri I.P. Mishra, in his welcome speech said workshop on this topic was happening in Durg University for the first time. Awareness about Patent is the need of the hour. He explained the importance of Patent and Copyrights through the example of Basmati Rice and Texmati Rice controversy.

Dr.K. Subramaniam (Director General, CGCOST, Raipur), added in Chhattisgarh there is lack of awareness about IPR. This type of workshop will help to generate and spread awareness about Property Rights. He appreciated the college Principal Dr. Raksha Singh for suggesting such an innovative topic for the workshop. He explained the example of Yew Tree (Texas Batata). He shared that in 1967 lyrics writer Anand Bakshi and others fought a case in court that their name should be mention with the song and they won the case with help of Patent Act. He gave information regarding the Trade Related Intellectual Right. In European countries, people who are having their copyrights do not need any money from the Govt. because they are earning money from their copyrights. China has the maximum leading percentage in Patent whereas India is lagging behind. So the awareness about the Intellectual Property Rights is important because it will ignite our mind. Further he added the example of Dr. Punit Gupta who had invented a dialysis belt and trying to get a copyright for this process. He stated every individual should upgrade his knowledge and syllabus should be changed accordingly.

Next Eminent speaker, Dr. Amit Dubey (Senior Scientist, CCOST) had explained about IPR, Intellectual Property Right “Law of Land”. Nobody else can lawfully use one’s property without the persons concern. Basics of IPR are “the creation of mind” which is new and original in the global context. Maruti and Suzuki had collaboration with each other, so comparatively they are selling the maruti car in cheaper rates. In ancient time also there was monopoly for example Eklavya of Mahabharata and Taj Mahal. Vaidyas and Hakims never disclose their process of treatment. He concluded by “The Patents add fuel of Interest to the fire of genius- Abraham Lincon”



Assistant Professor, Research Scholars and Students from different colleges were present in the workshop in a large number.

Mr. Sandeep Jashwant and Mrs. Preeti Shrivastava were the Convener of the program. Total 63 registrations were done from different colleges.



On the second day of the workshop, the Resource Person was Pankaj P. Borkar (Dy. Controller of Patents and Designs, RGNIIPM). He further explained how to file Patent Application, and highlighted that Chhattisgarh comes under the section of Mumbai Patent Office.

Abhishek Amrasta (CEO, TECH.B COMPANY, DELHI) stated Intellectual Property Rights helps to foster innovation. A Patent is essential because it gives the inventor, the exclusive rights for a limited period, to prevent others from using his researchr without permission.

Each of these cores have a number of functional units, such as arithmetic and logic units (ALUs) etc. One or more of these functional units are used to process each thread of execution. These group of functional units that help the thread are called "**thread processors**". All thread processors in a core of GPU perform the same instructions, as they share the same control unit. 12 students with our CS staffs participated in this guest lecture a got benefit from this knowledge full session.

Guest lecture on Clustering in Wireless Sensor Networks

Shri S. D. Mishra gives the lecture in the topic of Clustering in Wireless Sensor Networks. Wireless sensor networks (WSN) are spatially distributed separate sensors to monitor physical or environmental conditions, like temperature, sound, pressure, etc. as well as to cooperatively push through their data through the network to a base station. The WSN is built of nodes from a few to several hundreds or even thousands, where each node is connected to each other sensors. Clustering is one of the important methods for extend the network lifetime in wireless sensor networks (WSNs). It involves grouping of sensor nodes into clusters and electing cluster heads (CHs) for all the clusters. CHs collect the data from particular clusters nodes and forward the aggregated data to base station, so in order to energy efficient clustering is well known optimization problem which has been calculated widely to extend lifetime of wireless sensor networks (WSNs) and there are many types of clusters .

All these trends are set against the introduction and challenges associated with GDPR. Regulatory impacts on the way in which events marketers acquire visitors has been a major agenda item in the industry.



For any of the Administration Competitive Exam minimum age criteria is of 21 years and max up to 32 years (for general) and 37 years (for SC & ST) you can appear in the examination. The general category student can give maximum upto 6 times and SC-ST students can appear each year till the age criteria permits. For the preparation of the interview one should focus on personality development, reasoning power, decision taking and physical appearance according to the post applied. For seeking to compete in these exams, student should develop writing skills and also discuss on the topic with other students also, and welcome their thoughts over the subject. A deep study of the subject is compulsory. Program was anchored by Dr. Mahendra Sharma, on this occasion HOD Dr. Jaishree Wakankar, Dr. Lakshmi Verma, Smt. Several improvements such as indexing of all video and web courses and keyword search were implemented.
